Knowing English will make your ward more expressive, and confident and excel in all spheres of life. Keeping the same in mind, we have introduced a period weekly for enhancing Language proficiency. The mentors will provide the students required material to sharpen their linguistic skills.

• Preparation for the Competitive Exams:

Dear parents, now the Academic Session 2022-23 is reaching its culmination & we are preparing ourselves with full vigour for Session 2023-24. We request all our parents to adhere to the following points.

- 1. Session 2023-24 will commence on March 23, 2023.
 - School Timings for **Grades III to XII** will be **8:00 a.m. to 2:20 p.m**. From **3 April 2023** onwards, the school will follow the timings: **7:30 a.m. to 1:50 p.m.**
- 2. Kindly make sure that your ward has the required books for the new class and the summer uniform before the start of the new session. School uniform will be available at Suman Vastralaya, Sadar Bazar, Gurgaon, and Stationery will be available at Niti Stationery, Sector 14, Gurgaon from March 18, 2023 to March 31, 2023. The parents have the option to procure the uniform and stationery from any outlet at their convenience. But it should conform to the design & specifications prescribed by the school. Uniforms and stationery will also be available in the school from 18 March 2023 to 25 March 2023.

Kindly follow the given Uniform Code.

- Monday to Friday:
- ➤ Girls –Plaid frock with beige coloured yoke (Grade I to V) & Checkered Half sleeved shirt with school logo and Beige skirt pleated (Grade VI to XII)
- ➤ Boys -Checkered half-sleeved shirt with school logo + Beige shorts (Grade I to V) / Beige Trousers (Grade VI to XII)
- > Dark brown sports shoes, Beige socks with two maroon stripes, and a striped belt with the school logo.

• Wednesday and Saturday:

- ➤ Girls -White Tunic with white Shirt with school logo (Grade I to XII)
- ➤ Boys -White shorts (Grade I to V)/White Trousers (Grade VI to XII) and White shirt with school logo
- ➤ Dark brown sports shoes, White socks with two maroon stripes, and a striped belt with the school logo.
- Hairstyle No fancy hairstyle for both Boys & Girls.
- ➤ Girls: Hair must be fastened with white/black hair-band in one/two ponytails(short hair)/plaits(long hair)
- **Boys:** Must put on a simple gentle-man hairstyle.
- 3. School provides transport facilities on all the major routes. The list of routes will be shared shortly with you. If the pick and drop point of your ward doesn't fall in the list, please inform the transport in charge or the school reception and get it confirmed whether buses ply on the specific route or not.
 - Kindly inform the class in charge well in advance if there is a change in address or pick & drop point to avail smooth bus services. Also, submit the details of the driver to the respective class teachers if your ward commutes by private van.
- 4. Cover all the books and copies and label them properly.
- 5. Please inform the class teacher if the child is facing any sort of health issue.
- 6. Every Saturday will be off for Class XI and XII Science Stream.
- 7. PTM for all the classes will be held on every fourth Saturday of the month.
- 8. The link to fee submission will be shared on the 1st of every month. Parents are requested to pay the fee between 1st to 15th of the month. Fee dues will be charged with a late fine of Rs 10/- per day if not paid on time. Parents can also pay the fees directly through the fee portal available on the website (davppsbhondsi.org) in case the link is not received.
